Study Prompts

- These **Study Prompts** may be distributed to the congregation:

Read Jonah 4:1-11.

1. Why is Jonah upset?
2. How often has the prosperity of another gotten under your skin?
3. Have you found yourself feeling like Jonah, who is “exceedingly displeased” and angry that God relents from bringing disaster upon the Ninevites?
4. How does God’s grace being given to another person assure you of his grace toward you?

Read Matthew 12:38-42.

1. The one sign which Jesus says will be provided is the sign of Jonah (a three day and three night confinement). To what two great events does Jesus’ three-day-and-three-night confinement refer?
2. How is Jesus similar to, and yet greater than Jonah?
